Items 1 to 7 will be chaired by the outgoing chairman, item 8 by an acting chairman and the remaining business by the newly elected chairman.

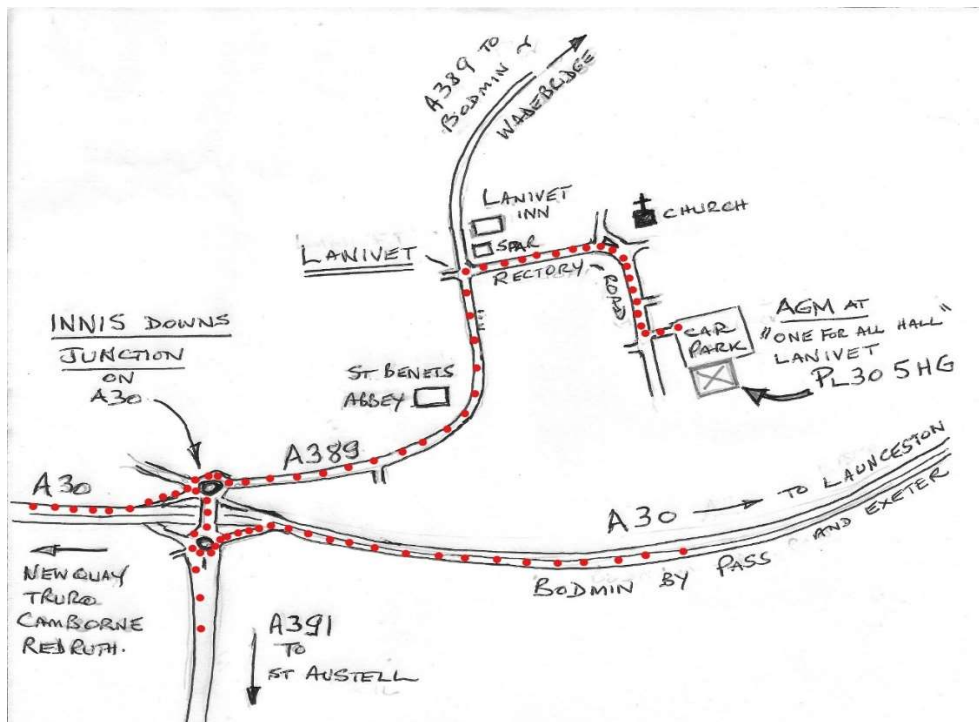

Lanivet is situated just north of the A30 at the Innis Downs Junction with the A391 to St Austell to the south and the A389 to Wadebridge and Bodmin to the north.

At the Innis Downs roundabout take the A389 (signposted to Lanivet, Wadebridge and Bodmin). In the centre of Lanivet turn right into Rectory Road by the SPAR stores and follow the road round to the right. Go past the church on your left and the Community Centre is in Carters Parc, which is about 100 metres on your left (just past the narrow section in Rectory Road). There is a large free car park on site. We will be in the main hall.

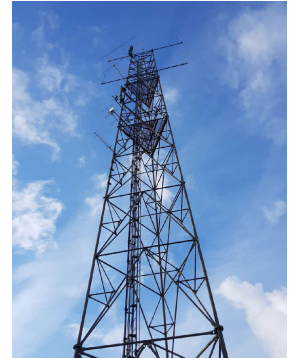
